



Injectable Medications

The injectable medications listed below are covered under the Plan's medical benefit. These require pre-authorization and can be obtained from Maxor Mail Order. The approval process is simple:

If request is submitted directly to Maxor:

- the clinical pharmacist will confirm with the prescriber that the dose and directions are appropriate for the diagnosis
- if the prescription is for an FDA approved indication, the Maxor clinical pharmacist will issue an authorization
- If the prescription is not FDA approved, the Maxor clinical pharmacist will contact the Plan's utilization review department for physician medical necessity review

If request is submitted directly to the Plan's UR department:

- UR staff will accept clinical and confirm that the dose and directions are appropriate for the diagnosis
- UR staff will notify member, prescriber and Maxor of approval or denial

Maxor Mail Order can ship approved injectable medications directly to the physician or to the member. Physicians may opt not to accept the mail order supply and may submit the claim to the Plan directly.
