



TRICARE Uniform Formulary Quantity Limits

Categories of Prescription Drugs and Related Supplies with Quantity Limits

Quantity limits are applied by the Department of Defense (DoD) to address the issue of overuse of medications that can be unsafe for the patient and costly to the government. Examples of categories of prescription medications and related supplies subject to quantity limits includes, but is not limited to: adrenals, antiallergic agents, antidepressants, antiemetics, antimigraine agents, blood glucose strips, controlled substances, erectile dysfunction agents, fertility agents, lancets, nasal/oral inhalers, syringes and needles used for injectable medications, topicals. Exceptions to established quantity limits may be made if the prescribing provider is able to justify medical necessity. Quantity limit override form is available on the pharmacy page of the Plan's website. Members may not submit an override request.
